Linear Integrated Systems designs and manufactures specialty semiconductors. Our components are integral to high-performance applications such as military underwater surveillance, space telescope cameras, high-fidelity audio equipment, and advanced aerospace sensors. We've been a successful business since 1987, and we continue to look for ways to improve and optimize our operations.
